SDBJ INVESTS \$1.2 MILLION TO DEVELOP CARGO SERVICES AT LA GRANDE RIVIÈRE AIRPORT

Matagami, March 16, 2022 – The Société de développement de la Baie-James (SDBJ) is pleased to announce that it is investing \$1,200,000 in the project to expand the Valpiro inc. hangar and cargo handling space at La Grande Rivière Airport.

Highlights

- Through the addition of nearly 10,000 square feet, the project will enable Valpiro inc. to double its warehousing capacity so that it can better meet its customers' needs;
- The project will enable Valpiro inc. to adequately respond to the growing demand for goods from Inuit communities and mining companies north of the 55th parallel;
- The investment will improve supply logistics at La Grande Rivière Airport, so that the
 company is better able to respond to climate-change-related storage and packing
 issues that lead to delays in air shipments and create the need for more storage
 space.
