# SDBJ ANNOUNCES PRIVATE PLACEMENT OF \$120,000 IN SIRIOS RESOURCES INC.

**Matagami, December 17, 2020** – The Société de développement de la Baie-James (SDBJ) is proud to announce its private placement of \$120,000 in mining exploration company Sirios Resources Inc. (Sirios Resources), in exchange for 800,000 units at \$0.15 a unit. Each unit consists of one common share and one common share purchase warrant at \$0.23 for 18 months.

The shares issued pursuant to the private placement are subject to a four-month holding period to expire on April 17, 2021. The company will use the proceeds of the private placement to finance work on its Cheechoo project in James Bay.
