Canadian Navigable Waters Act

The Société de développement de la Baie-James (hereinafter SDBJ) hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the online Common Project Search registry, under the provisions of the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act*, for public comment as set out herein and for the project's site and plans.

In accordance with subparagraph 10 (1)(b) of said Act, SDBJ filed with the Minister of Transport, in the online Common Project Search registry (<https://common-project-search.canada.ca/>) and under registry numbers 7400, 7405 and 7406, a description of the following work, site and plans:

3 bridges to replace 3 sets of culverts on Billy-Diamond Highway:

- At kilometre 49+475, on Rivière Canet (registry number 7400)
- At kilometre 66+293, on a stream that empties into Lac Soscumica (registry number 7405)
- At kilometre 69+808, on a stream that empties into Lac Soscumica (registry number 7406).
